What is FASD?

Fetal alcohol spectrum disorders (FASD) is an umbrella term describing the range of birth defects caused by prenatal alcohol exposure.

FASD is a disability with lifelong implications that can impact brain function, development, learning, behavior and social skills.

Signs that your child may benefit from an FASD assessment include:

- Hearing or vision problems
- Difficulty in school
- Poor coordination
- Sensitivity to light, touch, or sound
- Hyperactive behavior
- Difficulty paying attention
- Memory issues
- Poor social skills
- Impulsivity
- Poor reasoning
- Poor judgment skills
